

# "Ryan White Part A" Programs

#### Medical Case Management (MCM)

Thursday's Child Case
Management provides linkage to
HIV care and other supportive
services. We specialize in serving
those who are newly diagnosed,
out-of-care, or experiencing
challenges maintaining care.
Medical Case Management
services can help address
concerns such as housing, food,
insurance, transportation, benefits,
and managing appointments.

# Emergency Financial Assistance (EFA)

Food or housing insecurity can be major barriers to care. Our program can provide Emergency assistance to eligible HIV+ individuals experiencing hardship in these areas. The "EFA" program can provide grocery store cards, utility assistance (in the face of termination), and some limited short-term housing-related assistance on a case-by-case basis.

### **Other Services**

Safety Net/AIDS Services
Access program: can provide
resources not covered under
other benefits, such as

- Personal care and household cleaning supplies
- Transportation vouchers
- Clothing or household essentials
- HIV information and referral services

#### **Support Groups:**

Special social support group for Long Term Survivors & more. Please call the office for more details.

Eligibility for Ryan White Part A, MCM and EFA include verification of HIV+ status, income under 500% of the Federal Poverty Level, and proof of Nassau or Suffolk residency, regardless of immigration status. Veterans are eligible regardless of income level
